CATHOLIC EDUCATION WEEK

Last year there were 20,808 students in 77 Catholic schools in BC. The first week of February this year is Catholic Education Week when we celebrate our schools! We are blessed to have the

when we celebrate our schools! We are blessed to have the opportunity to have a Catholic school in Smithers. Our Catholic schools in the diocese came about in the 1950s when Bishop

O'Grady led parishes to secure grants, and to donate materials, labour, and money to build the schools. He also started the Frontier Apostle Program where young Catholic teachers from the United Kingdom were recruited to work for free in the "frontier towns" of northwestern BC alongside the nuns and brothers (who also worked for free!)

To start Catholic Education Week, on Monday, February 3rd, parents, younger siblings, and grandparents are invited to join the school for a morning walk and muffins. This will happen first thing when the bell rings at 8:34. We will all walk for 20 minutes in the playground then come into the gym for home-made muffins and coffee. On Friday, February 7th, we will end Catholic Education Week with a school mass at 9:00 am. Further activities will be finalized at the staff meeting this week and communicated home after that.

Administration of the Sacraments

MARRIAGE. Please make an appointment with the pastor, at least six months before the intended marriage date. Marriage Preparation may then be arranged.

HOLY ORDERS. Any person interested to become a priest, please see the pastor.

ANNOINTING OF THE SICK. Parish care for the sick and homebound, please phone the parish office for a pastoral visit.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS. Please see the pastor for RCIA journey.

FUNERALS. Please make funeral arrangements directly with the pastor prior to any public notice.

Our lady of the Immaculate Conception, Family Marian Hour of Prayer

Every year an icon of our lady travels throughout each Knights of Columbus jurisdiction as a focus of the Family Hour of Prayer Devotion. This year the chosen Icon is Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception. The image is presently displayed for veneration at our Church until Tuesday next week.

The image used is a reproduction of a painting of Mary, as the Immaculate Conception, that hangs above the main altar of the Basilica-Cathedral of Notre Dame de Quebec. It was painted in 1925 by Sister Mary of the Eucharist, a sister of Charity of Quebec, to replace an 18th century painting destroyed during a fire at the cathedral.
