A Serious Issue With Development and Peace: The Canadian Catholic Organizatin for Development and Peace (CCODP) was founded by the bishops of

Canada in 1967 as part of a worldwide organization supporting development projects in poor countries.

This cooperation is now jeopardized by serious and credible allegations against 40 different partner groups in developing countries, chosen by the CCODP, that actively promote initiatives contrary to Catholic moral teaching.

The bishops of western Canada agreed that proceeds of annual Share Lent collection will be withheld by their dioceses until assurances are given that the CCODP will not fund these partner organizations with any of its revenues, either from dioceses or other sources.

Our support of the poor in developing countries should continue, but we need assurances that local partners will always respect the criteria of *Caritas Internationalis* and recognize and comply with Catholic moral teaching.
