It is with profound sadness; we announce the death of Fr. Tom Shymko who died shortly after 7:00 PM, Friday, May 11, 2018 in the University Hospital of Northern British Columbia. As previously announced Fr. Tom was diagnosed with aggressive non-Hodgkin Lymphoma, and was undergoing treatment. He was transferred to ICU on Friday afternoon where he died. 
